Thank you for your letter of the 8th. The Rember infrared amplifier sounds like the one I am interested in. Please look over the instruction sheet and let me know what frequency it works at and how many tubes it requires plus its approximate dimensions. Better yet, I'd much appreciate having a look at the instruction sheet and page out of Radio to help me identify the equipment if you would be kind enough to loan these to me for a few days.

In addition to the amplifier I'll need a set of 199 tubes and any other parts of the complete receiver, such as tuner <sup>with</sup> etc. which you may have.

I have looked over your wanted list and unfortunately don't have anything even approximately along the lines you need as I have very little old radio gear. My main interest is to make the amplifier work <sup>and</sup> measure up its electrical characteristics and learn the state of engineering science when it was designed. Consequently I am only able to offer cash and not too much of that. Please let me know what you consider a fair price for the amplifier and any associated receiver parts you may have.
