Dear Bruce:

Thank you for your note of the 24th December and the interesting enclosures. Next time I write to my people in NYC I'll have them send three dollars to keep me in good standing.

Someone told me that you ran a ditty on my early radio astronomy experiments in the OT Bull. I have vol.2, numbers 2,3,4 here but am unable to find anything. If such be true, I'd appreciate a copy for my archives.

Nothing more has been heard about the radio effects of Clifford Kunz. I suspect that his widow still has the equipment stored away somewhere.

A couple of months ago I got around to testing that SM 440, 112kc amplifier in copper can. After some fixing it worked very well with remarkable freedom from regeneration. If the OT Bull. would like to try something scientific, I'll write up a short article containing a picture of the device, a circuit diagram, two graphs showing gain and selectivity, a table of transformer parameters and 200 words of discussion. It should all go on one page. I probably have more complete performance information than the designer. Perhaps this will create enough interest to turn up the designer and/or induce others to similar efforts.

Can anyone locate a RUSCO I.F. amplifier system?
