We regret this delay in sending payment for the three special filters ordered by Mr. Grote Reber. Apparently the reply to my letter of March 26 was lost in the mails, for we received no acknowledgment of the order. We received the original order of six filters in June but assumed there was some reason why that order was not held for the additional filters.

According to your statement dated June 3, 1959, we have a credit balance of some 34 pounds. Accordingly, the enclosed bank draft in the amount of 246 pounds is for the three filters at 90 pounds each, plus 10 pounds which is our approximation of the shipping and insurance costs (based on the previous order for six filters), less the credit balance of 34 pounds. Should this amount not be sufficient, please let us know, but we hope that it will be possible for you to ship the filters at the earliest possible time.

Would you please address this shipment to: Research Corporation, 405 Lexington Avenue, New York, N.Y., rather than to Mr. Grote Reber, in care of Research Corporation. We have been advised that this will expedite matters at this end, since Mr. Reber is not here to receive the shipment and it must be sent on to him in West Virginia.
