This is just a note to mention that we have had some correspondence with Hagen regarding the solar eclipse observations of 12th September 1950. We have just sent him copies of our records on 3 and 10 cm. over the same time. I have been assuming that you and he were working together on this but in case you are not in immediate touch I thought I should let you know so that you could arrange to see his copies of our results if they should be of any use to you. The information is not great - steady signals on 3 and 10 cm., and on 50 cm. (no record sent) a badly cut up record with a constant value whenever measured.
