Dear Mr. Reber:

The "hard point" to which Mr. Schauer refers is that a couple of letters from the Internal Revenue Director, a communication dated June 5th and a bill dated July 7, have only just arrived from Green Bank. Since the latter noted that further steps would be taken, I wrote them and explained that the letters had only just been forwarded here and that we in turn had to forward them to you in Australia.
