TO PROBE UNIVERSE

BEHIND cattle grazing quietly in a mea-

dow in Cheshire, England, rises the world's biggest telescope which will soon be probing deeper into the secrets of the universe than ever before.

Being completed at a cost of about £650,000, the telescope will be used

to study the invisible "radio stars" which can be detected by the radio waves they emit.

It comprises a 30-ton mesh bowl suspended between two 180ft, towers and rotated on a circular railway track.
