

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 21st day of November, 1952, by and between MUTUAL TELEPHONE COMPANY, party of the first part, hereinafter called the "Licensor", and GROTE REBER, party of the second part, hereinafter called the "Licensee",

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, the Licensor is Licensor under that certain Indenture of License dated May 4, 1951, embracing all the premises mentioned and described in that certain General Lease No. 3342, dated March 1, 1950, by and between the Territory of Hawaii and the Licensor, together with Easements A & B as more particularly set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, it is mutually desired to extend said License dated May 4, 1951;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, it is mutually agreed that said License dated May 4, 1951, and the term thereof, shall be and by these presents is declared to be renewed and extended for an additional term to and including May 3, 1956, and thereafter until terminated upon thirty (30) days' written notice by either the Licensor or the Licensee, at and upon the covenants and conditions in said License set forth.

In all other respects the terms, covenants and conditions of said License dated May 4, 1951 are hereby confirmed and made a part hereof to be observed and performed during this extension as if said terms, covenants and conditions were contained in a new formal indenture of license.
