- 1. A soil sample was authorized to be made at the 85-foot telescope site. This sample was selected by Mr. Carroll and forwarded to Pittsburgh Testing Lab with the road soil samples on August 7, 1957. This test will establish a safe bearing capacity for the 85-foot telescope site alluvium overburden. Costs of this additional sample to be borne with the road sample tests now being conducted through Irving Bowman & Associates, project architects, and Pittsburgh Testing Co.
- 2. The following action was agreed:
  - a. Foundations for the 85-foot telescope will be included in the proposed Blaw-Knox contract if practicable in point of time, weather factors, cost, and utilization of staff capacity at Green Bank site.
