Dear Mr. Reber:

In answer to your letter of July 12, to the best of my knowledge the University of Chicago is no longer accepting samples for Carbon-14 dating except ⁱⁿ very unusual circumstances. A number of other laboratories have been established for Radio-carbon dating. I suggest that you write: Dr. H. R. Crane, Memorial-Phoenix Project, Radio-carbon Laboratory, University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, Michigan. I believe the cost of running a single specimen is in the neighborhood of \$300.
