Dear Grote:

The third paragraph of your note of March 31 starts out "Working backwards . . ." I get some impression of wheels spinning as you work backward. I am afraid the kind of schedule you'd like is impossible. I am enclosing what seems to be a feasible itinerary bearing as good as possible a relation to the dates and times you have specified. The travel agents are going ahead with this schedule; unless we hear from you before the first of May we will assume that the arrangements are satisfactory.
