Dear Mr. Reber:

I am glad the tickets arrived. I had picked up some for Greg Schauer on the same day and then wondered, Fridays being what they are, whether I might have switched them and had you headed for Parry Sound, Ontario.

Harris Trust and Savings Bank has sent the certificate representing 50 shares of Gary-Wheaton Bank stock, which you requested. I have acknowledged its receipt but will keep the memo which they want returned for you to sign personally. Unless, that is, they write back and say they have to have it right away.

Harris Trust etc. has also notified you that as of August 1, 1962, the balance in your savings account was \$15,433.89.

The bill from Internal Revenue Service came in. Since it had to be paid within 10 days ("or they would take the necessary action, etc.") I decided not to take a chance on its maybe not negotiating the round trip in time so I borrowed from petty cash and paid it. You may reimburse petty cash when you arrive (\$71.28 plus 20 cents check fee).

I've asked the Purchasing Dept. in Bound Brook to look into the metal foil question. They knew about invar steel but thought it might not come in strips 2 feet wide. However, they will get the details and let me know. I assume you want this information when you arrive here and not before.
