Dear John:

During my visit several years ago, you showed to me a couple of esoteric bicycles with odd-ball steering etc. Recently I've become interested in these matters and have secured a book "Bicycling Science" by R.F. Whitt & D.G. Wilson, 2nd edition, 1982 MIT Press, US\$9.95 I wrote direct to MIT Press, 525 Great Road (route 119), Littleton, Mass., 01460 and enclosed an extra US\$1.05 for handling and postage.

Pages 217-221 describe some Unridable Bicycles (URB) similar to yours. They could be ridden with difficulty. Pages 233-236 describe rear steering bicycles which could not be ridden. The book has a lot of composing errors. These can be recognized by study and comparison.

Enclosed is a note which appeared in Physics Today, Nov. 82, p 108 & 9. The response was surprising. The university received over 70 requests. These came from 24 states in USA plus 10 other countries. Physics Today really gets around. I never realized such a large number of people are fed-up with Big-Bang cosmology. A peculiarly large number were attracted by the religious aspect. Perhaps God is not dead yet!
