The Committee on Radio Frequency Allocations for Scientific Research of the National Academy of Sciences has sent a memorandum to "Contributors to 'Frequency Allocations for the Radio Astronomy Service - A Statement of Position, June 1961,' calling attention to three documents issued by the FCC as follows:

- Docket No. 14475 Amendment to Part 2 of the Rules and Regulations to modify the existing frequency allocation provisions for the radio astronomy service.
- Docket No. 14476 Amendment of Part 2 of the Commission's Rules & Regulations to insert provisions for the notification of the International Telecommunication Union relative to radio astronomy observatories and frequencies involved.
- Docket No. 14477 An Inquiry into the Allocation of Frequency Bands for Radio Astronomy.

The Committee states further that the complete texts may be obtained from the FCC and that all documents invite comments submitted to the Commission on or before February 26, 1962.
