Dear Sir:

Regarding your letter of May 14, 1956, this office has no open power of attorney on record from yourself, to your brother, Schuyler C. Reber.

Back in 1945, a power of attorney was recorded, from Schuyler C. Reber to yourself, but it was revoked in 1947, and is now void.

Under the circumstances, there is nothing that we can do to help you in this instance, without any instrument being on record. Incidentally, in cases of this kind, where a power of attorney is revoked, it is not possible to return the original power of attorney record to the person wishing to have it cancelled. To begin with, we have only a photostatic copy of the instrument on record, and to cancel it requires the recording of a new instrument, which indicates that the power of attorney is no longer in effect.

If you can furnish us with further details which might enlighten us in this matter, we shall be very glad to go into the situation again.
