Thank you for your letter of 9th November, in answer to mime to Dr. Holloway.

The experiment in question is part of a study of twining vines being conducted by Dr. Grote Reber, a visitor to this Leberstery. It is hoped that by proper exposure to X-rays some of the seed can be induced to make vines which will voluntarily turn in reverse direction or produce other interesting effects.
