Dear Sirs,

The sample metal box made for Mr. Reber last month has been tested and found satisfactory with the following alterations.

1. Increase lip at bottom from $\frac{1}{4}$ " to $\frac{1}{2}$ " and size of cover appropriately.
2. Close corner slots on back of cover at top by folding top lip over sides or by soldered triangular patch.
3. Holes on top to be drilled $\frac{15}{32}$ " dia. by suitable bit to produce clean edge. Bit provided by C.S.I.R.O.
4. Drill with similar bit a $\frac{1}{4}$ " hole in back centre at 1" above bottom.
5. Fasten on back by two rivets spaced 10" apart and 1" down from top, a bracket supplied by C.S.I.R.O.,
6. One $\frac{5}{32}$ " dia. hole in centre of each end.
7. Four $\frac{5}{32}$ " holes at corners of 3" square centred on $3\frac{1}{2}$ " holes in bottom. Make accurate drilling template to fit into $3\frac{1}{2}$ " holes to insure uniformity.

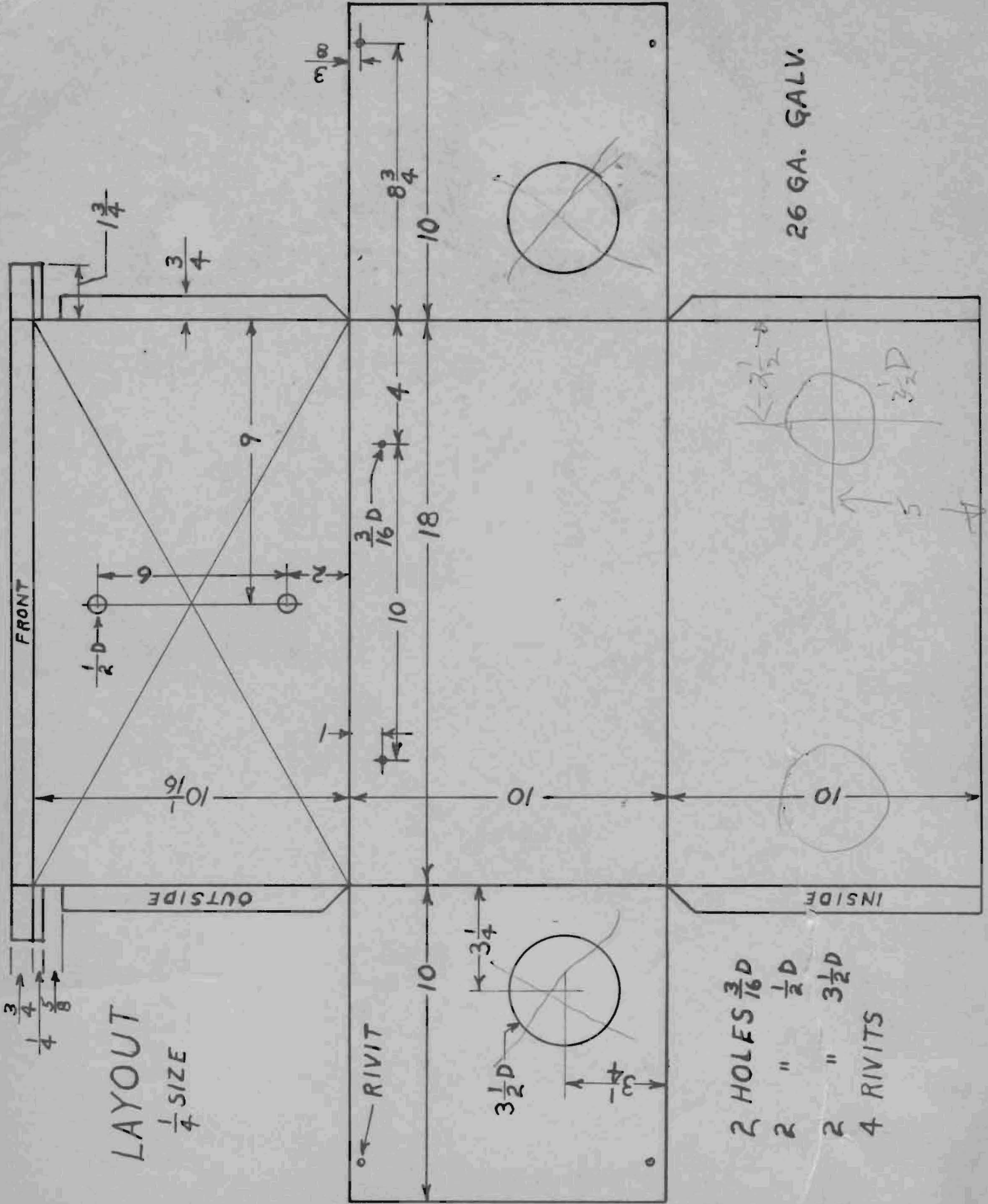

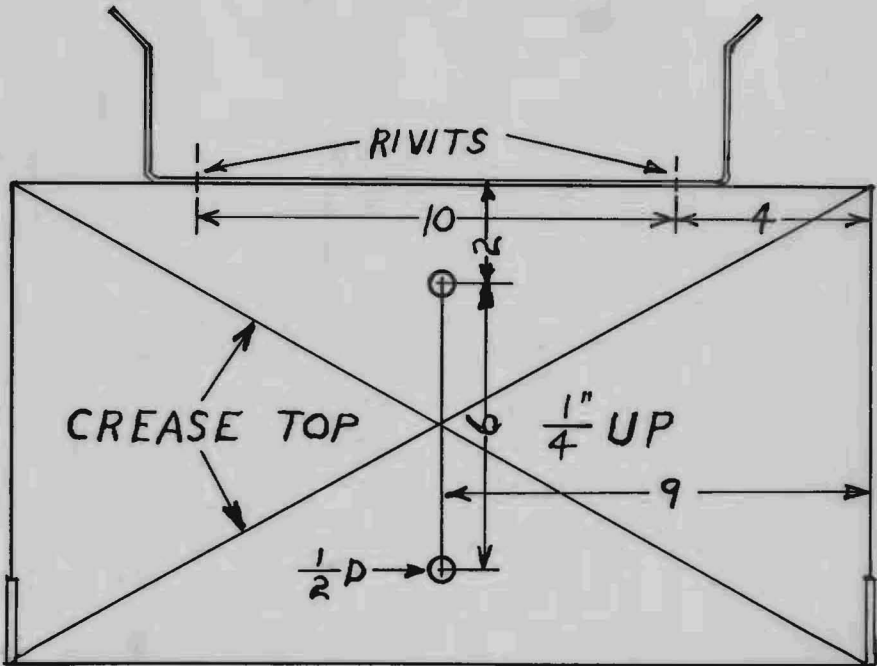


FLANGE WITH TIGHT CORNERS OVER COVER

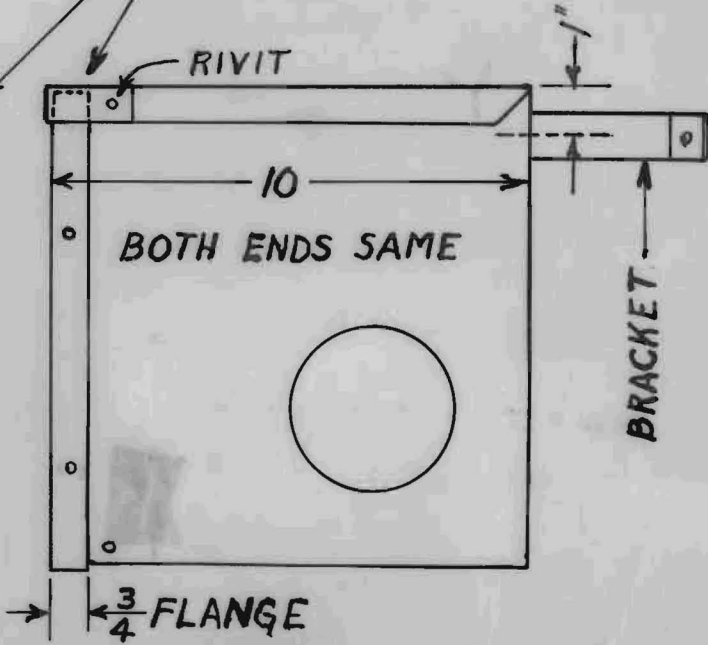
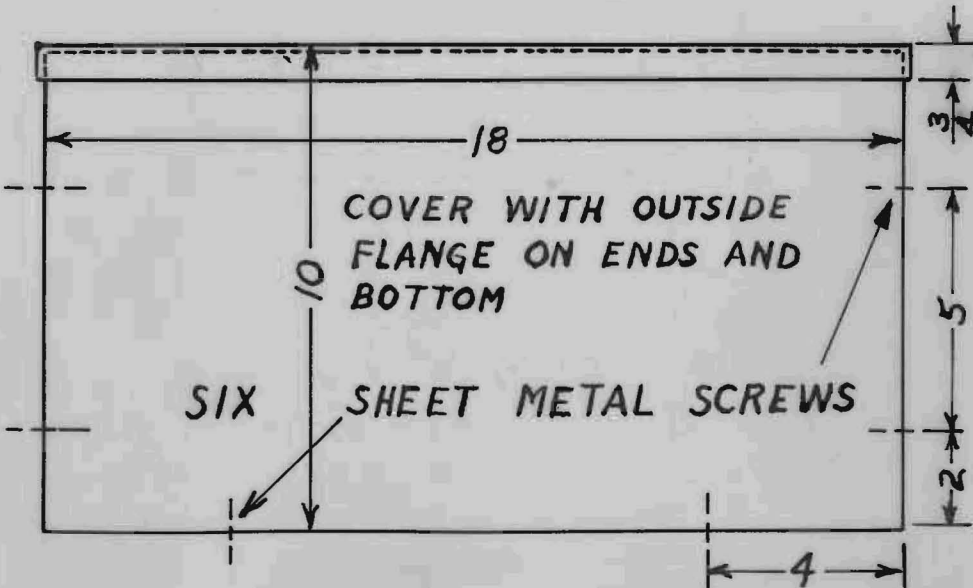

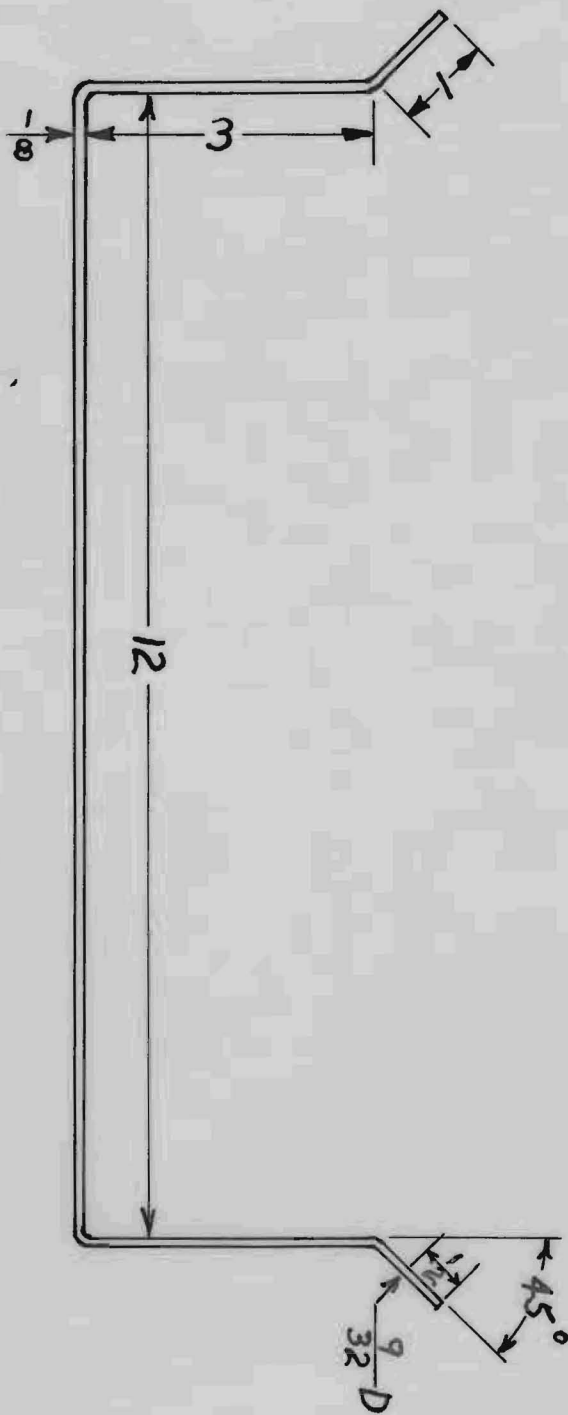
