Thank you for yours of October 30th. There are a few things I'd like to secure as follows.

From Brush Electronics Co., Cleveland, Ohio.

Two bottles of purple ink No.7083, each bottle $1\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter and $4\frac{1}{2}$ " high overal with syringe in cap. Cost about a dollar.

From General Radio Co., Cambridge, Mass

40 cable connectors type 874-c8 to fit type RG/8U cable, each 2.00 dollars	80.00
5 Panel connectors type 874-P @2.50	12.50
1 Adaptor type 874-Q2	5.00
total	<u>97.50</u>

I seem to remember that they make some spiral spring locks which wind around these connectors and prevent the cables being accidentally pulled apart. The catalog here is pretty old and doesn't list them. However please make inquiry and get a ~~half~~ dozen if they are available. The cost is very small. Also have them send three copies of large inductance chart shown on page 235 of catalog M. These are free.
