Answering inquiry herewith, postmasters and postal employees are prohibited by the Regulations from giving information upon request as to the names or addresses of patrons of the service.

If a letter bearing your return request is directed to person named and received at this office, it will be delivered or forwarded if person's address is known, or returned to you with reason for nondelivery.

However, provision has been made for the sender of a domestic registered ^{or certified} article to obtain a return receipt showing where the article was delivered upon payment of a fee of ~~32~~³⁵ cents in addition to the postage and registry fee at the time of mailing, in which event the article should be marked "Return receipt requested showing address where delivered." In such cases when delivery is made by carrier at the street address the carrier will note the address on the return receipt; if delivery is made at the post office or a post office station the return receipt will be marked to that effect. If delivery is not made, the registered article will be returned endorsed with the reason for its non-delivery.*
