Dear Dr. Kelleher:

Thank you for your letter of the 4th. The letter of credit you mention will be entirely satisfactory. It should be made out to a bank in Hobart where I will be doing business. Chase can probably give you the name of a reliable bank as I don't have such information yet. I would like a copy of the letter of credit to show the consul here.

My address in Hobart is presently unknown. However, I will be staying at the Wentworth Hotel Limited (no street address given) in Sydney for the first ten days of November.

Presently, I have a passport, a paid passage on the Orion, an export permit for my apparatus, a hotel reservation and friends in Australia who are taking out an import permit for my apparatus. Upon receipt of a copy of your letter of credit an Australian visa should be issued. Thus everything seems to be in order.

I will keep you advised of my progress.
