You will remember my writing that the Edison Company had declared a stock dividend, and it seems that you are entitled to 4 and 6/25th shares. Enclosed is a card which you may or may not return. If you want to round out the fraction of a share, you should mark Box 2 and they will bill you for the additional amount due. If you want to sell your fraction, either check Box 1 and return, or ignore the card and they will sell your fraction, which cannot be distributed.
