Then via Trans Australian Airlines from Sydney to Hobart.

By an old letter, I gather that you were able to negotiate <sup>my</sup> checks from Gary Wheaton Bank. Thus you should have sufficient funds to prepay the express to San Francisco.

The water and air freight will be paid at this end. I am writing to San Francisco advising them to look

for the package and get it aboard the first boat. The Oronsay leaves San Francisco on August 5th. The Oronsay leaves on September 10th. It may be possible to get the package on the Oronsay which arrives in Sydney on <sup>August</sup> 22nd.

The only difficulty you may encounter is getting an export clearance from the custom people in Chicago. However they should issue you one without any trouble if the material is classified as <sup>Tools of Trade</sup> personal property not to be sold. This is Section 371.11 of Export Schedule. My original application # BFC 556911 was approved under this section on 7/27/54 by office of International Trade. Thus the above recorder should become part of this approval.

I have passage back to America on the Cronquist <sup>Steamer</sup> leaving Sydney on 12th November. However it is my intention to return here next February for another year's experiments. I hope to fold up what I have in Hawaii permanently on my way back. The results there were far too meager for the effort expended. This is a much better proposition both in results and environment.
