R.1520/1 4.1 gm. charcoal 2A R.1520/2 6.6 gm. charcoal 2D 10.3 gm. charcoal R.1520/3 2E R.1520/4 70 gms. sand R.1587/1 8.1gms. charcoal 9B R.1587/2 77 gms. sand

We have checked sands R.1520/4 and R.1587/2 and found less activity in them than the soil in this area. The comparison is as shown below for total Beta activity:
