Dear Mr. Reber:

Enclosed are copies of a letter and a notice from the F.W. Means & Company concerning Preference stock.

I am not sending the Letters of Transmittal or the return envelope at this time for several reasons.

One is that you may be in the states well before the deadline either for surrendering the stock (Aug. 16) or for exchanging it for common stock (Aug. 6). Another reason is that you may have the stock here. Do you? There is a large envelope in Mr. Schauer's file-safe marked "Property of Grote Reber," and it occurred to me that you might have left your stock certificates here. So please let me know if you want either or both Letters of Transmittal sent to you (one is for use in redeeming your stock; the other for exchanging it).

Not much mail to report. The Fair Radio Sales Co. of Lima, Ohio, has sent its catalogue.

The Aerospace Research Inc. company has sent you "descriptive literature of the Aerospace Research, Inc. RIOMETER-MARK II. This high precision instrument, which is in world-wide use by the U.S. and other governments, measures the relative absorption of extraterrestrial cosmic noise caused by electron density changes in the D-region of the ionosphere." They don't say how much so it must be expensive.

Mr. Schauer is in South America. Left last Friday for Santiago, and is now in Buenos Aires. He will be in several places in Brazil next week, returning to New York on the 9th.
