Dear Mr. Reber:

I have your communication of the 18 October 1962 relative to getting more seed of the Brodiaea volubilis, which is not a member of the Cactus Family. I regret to inform you that we do not have any seed available presently. The plant is a bulbous producing plant and is now dormant. We could not possibly provide seed from the counterclockwise and clock-wise stems. Your request is being filed for future handling, and when seed is produced next year, we shall hope to harvest the proper material. It will be necessary to properly mark each stem to indicate which way it turns as they come up very closely together and twist around each other.

We are most grateful for sending your article on the Reversed Bean Vines, and we shall file it with such information.
