Dear Mr. Reber:

In accordance with your letter of January 2, 1957, I am enclosing photostats of foF2 from Sao Paulo, Brazil for various months between May 1953 and May 1956, a total of 30 months in all as there are many gaps in this series of data. The data were taken on local time.

I am also sending copies of foF2 from Buenos Aires for the year 1950 with the exception of January and for the first five months of 1956. At a later date I hope to be able to send you similar photostats for Buenos Aires for the years 1951 through 1955 inclusive.

Although most of the copies from Sao Paulo are not marked with the name of the station I am sure you will have no trouble in distinguishing between the two stations for every Buenos Aires photostat is marked with the station name. It should be possible to send the remaining data so that it will reach you well before you leave your present address.
