Dear Mr. Reber:

A reply has come from AB PRODUKTIONSMATERIEL as follows:

price Sw.crs. 560: -- each net CIF.

"Delivery time one week and shipment by parcel post."

They also sent a booklet which I will put in the next packet of mail by sea for you, though you did not say you needed descriptive material.

I hope you received the tubing from Brush Instruments. We've had at least four communications from them indicating that they had mailed it and that there would be no charge.
