Dear Mr. Vail:

I have your letter of the 3rd. Since my first letter other considerations have required the following changed.

Length of cone reduced from 52" to 45".

Small end of cone increased from 8 7/16" I.D. to 10 5/16" I.D. This will give nearly the same taper.

Diameter of drums increased from 8 7/16" O.D. to 10 5/16" O.D. The same slip fit into small end of cone is required.

I am not familiar with what chipped and hammered means. The outside of ring must be smooth to turn easily in channel.

No mention is made of whether or not the bent up edges of fins are welded at the corners. I think they should be.

In regard to chuck charge of \$3.00; I will expect you to ship this and any scrap left over in fabrication process if you charge for same.

The third paragraph in your letter is not clear as to price. Is this per each or for two?

Please submit a new bid which includes the above alterations. How long will it take to perform the above work.
