Application to Import Seeds from U.S.A.

Advice is being sought from the Director of Plant Quarantine, Canberra, as to whether seed of Wild Yam, *Dioscorea Villosa* may be admitted and if quarantine restrictions apply.

Some time may be saved if the attached forms are lodged prior to the arrival of the seed and if this variety is subject to quarantine a certificate of health would be required from an approved authority in the country of origin accompanying the seeds.
