Dear Grote:

I can't be entirely certain what is cooking with the Loran equipment but possibly it has moved off dead center. Only time will tell, however.

I think that any hesitancy on the part of the Green Bank people, administrative or otherwise, may relate to complete uncertainty as regards your own plans. They, of course, are interested and concerned only with activities to be undertaken at Green Bank and, I would gather, have no definite expectations of activities or financing for your work in the current budget period. I must confess to more than a little uncertainty as far as any schedule of plans is concerned as well. I have a somewhat kaleidoscopic impression of a permanent fold-up on Maui, to be followed by a visit here and a return to Tasmania, thence to Macquarrie Island. I have no impression of the time schedule which may be involved in this, and I am looking forward to our next chance to get together for a little long-range planning.

There is an outside chance of my being in Hawaii sometime between March 10 and 20, en route back from the Philippines. If this works, I would expect to work in an expedition to Maui for a look at the installation. I wonder too if by some far outside chance your travels would take you to that location around that time. A personally conducted tour would be wonderful. If I go, I will be leaving
