Thank you for your letter of the 11th.
Enclosed is a reprint of previous work done on Phaseolus.
The results of the past two years will appear in Journal
of Genetics.

I will take up the subject of Vigna
in some detail with you next September. In the mean time,
if any vines with mature pods are available, I would like
to secure a few hundred well dried pods for initial test
and statistical analysis. If possible, the pods should
be collected in three levels: Under 1 foot, 1 to 4 feet,
and over 4 feet. The dried seed will be returned to you,
if you wish.
