I would like very much to know if your Michigan date M-361, A.D. 1356 plus or minus 300 (or 600 B.P.), and described as "roots of tree engulfed by lava flow covering ancient walls," is the Kamahina flow for which you later got the 6 14 date of 890 170 B.P. Also I would like to know where the walls were located which were covered in part by the flow for the 600 B.P. date. These are important dates for us, and the earliest we have so far from Maui.
