Dear Grote:

The telephone inquiry you suggested to the Millen Company indicated the probable usefulness of their 90672 Antenna Bridge with your grid dip meter under the desired conditions. However, they felt that a low frequency coupling coil would at least be helpful. Accordingly, there is going out from their export shipping agent, tonight I hope, an air express package containing bridge and coil, addressed in accordance with your instructions. The Millen people were going to write you in addition concerning their recommendation. Incidentally, your estimate on costs was about correct.
