



I have a one tube set that
was built by the Michigan Radio
Corp. in Grand Rapids Mich in the
early 20's. It uses a JV199 tube
and is wired with buss bar, as
far as I know it was one of the first
factory built sets on the market.
I don't have a picture of it but
will draw a rough sketch in
case you are not familiar with it.



as for the tubes that you mentioned
I have three UV199 and about twelve
② 299 tubes in Cunningham cartons but
they have been used I think.

I also have about seven old
home made sets that were built
in the early 20's by a local man
that had plenty of money to put in
to them. Some are in Solid Mahogany
cabinets with panel meters etc.
I am not sure but I think some
are early super-hets. These are
stored and I haven't seen them
for some time so I don't know
