Your most welcome letter of October 5 arrived October 10, and I wish to assure you absolutely that you are not imposing. The offer was freely made, and with your approach of forming a B.C. corporation, now I can be of some real assistance. My business for many years both in the States and in Canada has been the formation of companies and corporations.

I would like to suggest the following, believing it would very substantially expedite your project and put you in a position of total control.
