Dear Mr. Reber:

Enclosed are all the papers concerning your shipment which Mr. Campbell has asked me to send you. I did ask that your cases be labeled "Scientific Apparatus" rather than "Radios" as you requested, so I hope that was done. By the time the papers came over here the stuff was on its way.

I am also enclosing a communication from Central Aguirre Sugar Co. concerning withholding on dividends in Puerto Rico, since there seems to be some urgency in the form being returned if you want to do so.

Also enclosed is the notice of dues from the American Geophysical Union. I have tried to cancel your membership but they apparently don't think I mean it. This membership notice was included in a list of memberships, subscriptions, etc., about which I asked you sometime last spring or summer. Your reply indicated that you did not want to continue the AGU membership though you did not mention that specifically by name. So I wrote them at that time (or perhaps just returned their bill with a request to cancel). Early in December the enclosed bill came in so this time I wrote them, asking to cancel and telling them that you were in Australia; the latter as an explanation of why I was writing rather than you. Their reply was to the effect that they have members all over the world and that your being in Australia does not preclude the continuance of your membership, and that they have the feeling that you desire to continue! So would you please send them one of your Aerogramme notes telling them what you "desire" in this connection? The man who answered my letter is Waldo E. Smith, Executive Secretary. Incidentally, unless Green Bank is holding on to it, no material has come from the AGU in this past year. Mr. Schauer recently became a member and they immediately sent him all the 1961 issues of their publications.
